



English



Our class texts this term will include: *Sally & The Limpet*, *At The Beach* and *Katie Morag & The New Pier*.

In writing, the children will learn to write descriptions, non-chronological reports and persuasive writing.

Science

EYFS will find out about the plants and animals that live at the seaside.

Key Stage 1 will learn about the uses of everyday materials and how materials' properties make them suitable or unsuitable for specific purposes. They begin to explore how materials can be changed.

They will learn about the growth of plants from seeds and bulbs. They will observe the growth of plants first-hand, recording changes over time and identifying what plants need to grow and stay healthy.

Design & Technology

The children will learn about making and strengthening structures, including different ways of joining materials.

Art & Design

The children will learn about the visual elements of flowers, including shape, texture, colour, pattern and form. They also explore various artistic methods, including drawing, printmaking and 3-D forms, using paper and clay

What Are We Learning This Term? Early Years & Key Stage 1

Our Summer Term topic is :

Coastline



This project teaches children about the physical and human features of coastal regions across the United Kingdom, including a detailed exploration of the coastal town of Whitby, in Yorkshire.

Enrichment Activities

The children will visit Tynemouth and Long Sands Beach. As part of their fieldwork, they will look for the physical and human features they can see at the coast.

Religious Education

EYFS will find out about special buildings and how people worship there.

Key Stage 1 will be finding out about the key questions *How do Buddhists share their beliefs?* and *What can we learn about our local faith communities?*

Music

The children think about the question *How Does Music Make Us Happy?* They will find and keep a steady beat and learn to keep a steady beat when improvising. They will listen to the music carefully and move to the music.

Maths

EYFS will learn about numbers beyond 10 and 20. They will look at adding and taking away, and sharing and grouping. They learn about 3D and 2D shapes, and look at patterns.

Key Stage 1 will learn about multiplication & division, fractions and place value within 100. They will learn about mass and volume, length and height, and position and direction.

Computing

EYFS will sort and categorise data and will be introduced to branching databases and pictograms.

Key Stage 1 will learn about algorithms. They will decompose a game to predict the algorithms and create algorithms to solve problems. They will use different word processing skills, and use copy and paste to copy text from one document to another.

P.E.

The children will perform dances using simple movement patterns. They will practise developing their balance, agility and coordination. They will practise their hockey skills and participate in team games by developing simple tactics for attacking and defending.

PSHE & RSE

EYFS will talk about how to make friends and to solve friendship problems when they occur. They will understand that everyone is unique and special, and respect the changes that they see in themselves and in others.

Key Stage 1 think about how they can build positive, healthy relationships. They will talk about acceptable and unacceptable physical contact, and things that may cause conflict with friends. In Summer 2, they will understand that everyone is unique and special. They will understand and respect the changes that they see in themselves and in other people.
